

In September of 1997 I was in the Greensboro jail awaiting trial. White then ~~Dr~~ I had a disagreement with Ronnie Kimble. The same day Detective Church came at about 3:00 or 4:00 pm and sent for me. Church took me into his office. The way the conversation started was he asked me what happened between me and Ronnie. He told me that anything that has to do with Ronnie Kimble he knows it first, and that is ~~what~~ why he came to me. He told me what Ronnie was charged with and said he had a strong belief that Ronnie did it. During this conversation Church told me that ~~the~~ the Fed's wife had been shot with a 45 and that she had been chained to a chair and gasoline was poured on her and she was set on fire. I told him why Ronnie and I got into a disagreement. I told him that I had heard him talking about his case to Dominic Harris, and that I heard him talking on the telephone telling some one that he had been seen leaving the house in a car or a truck. ~~So~~. During this meeting he told me to go back and see if I could get Ronnie to talk or confess to the case. About 1 month later I had another meeting with Church. This meeting took place in the High Point CID.

There was another guy with him. Agent Pendergrass of the SBI was with him. Agent Pendergrass left to go get us some coffee. While he was gone Det. Church showed me 3 pictures. The first one was of a real pretty girl. The second picture was of ~~an~~ an open garage with a gas can in it. He told me that the gas can was used in the crime. The third picture he showed me was of a burned body. He had to point the body out to me. Det. Church told me not to tell anyone that he showed me these pictures. The way he said it was, "you didn't see these, I didn't show you these, don't tell nobody that I showed you these pictures."

Det. Church asked me if I had talked to ~~the~~ Ted since coming to the High Point jail. I said that we talked about Church and I showed him a little book that Ted had given me. Det. Church thumbed through the book and he came to a page and started writing. He asked me if he could have the book and I said sure, Ted gives out these books to all of the prisoners. We sat there and drank some coffee. He told me that he had to go to the high wire to talk to Dominic Harris. He said if I needed to talk to him to slip a note to one

of the guards. That is the last time I saw him. During this second meeting he promised me to help ~~me~~ me with my case. He said that what ever time I got I wouldn't have to serve it. He told me that he would contact my lawyer. I told him that I wanted something in writing he said he couldn't write anything in the investigation since it was on going but that he would have something written up that I could sign. I never told Det. Church that Ronnie or Ted committed any crime. I also do not know what Det. Church was writing down on paper during the time he was talking to me.

Sart Thursday Aug. 6, 1998 I was taken to the District Attorney's office in Greensboro. I had a meeting with Dick Panosh. Panosh got out a big book and opened it up. It appeared as though he was reading a page. We did not discuss as to what my testimony would be. Mr. Panosh then closed the book and told me that Det. Church could not be there because he was in Winston-Salem. Mr. Panosh told me that he had to go back to court and left. I have not talked to him since.
