4. Narrative: I SPOKE WITH SCOTT SHEPHERD 5417 SMILEY WYRICK ROAD, McLEANSVILLE, N.C. 656-4719, IN PERSON ON 10-20-95 AT 0710HRS. (B)

(A) - SCOTT SAID HE AND TED WAS PRETTY GOOD FRIENDS AT ONE TIME AND SAID THAT THE MOST HE REMEMBERED ABOUT TED WAS THAT HE WAS A CON-MAN THAT HE TORE HIS CAR UP ONCE AND TOLD SCOTT THAT HE WOULD PAY FOR THE REPAIRS, BUT DID NOT AND THAT HE ALWAYS HAD A ANGLE TO ANYTHING. (C)

(D) SCOTTER FURTHER STATED THAT A FEW THINGS HE REMEMBERED THAT OCCURRED 3 TO 5 YEARS AGO WAS THAT TED BOUGHT A MOTORCYCLE FROM HIM AND PAID HIM \$6,000.00 CASE FOR IT, HE BOUGHT AUTO SPEAKERS FROM TED THAT HE HAD SEEN TED BUY AND HE PAID TED BY CHECK AND TED GOT VERY UPSET ABOUT THE CHECK AND WANTED CASH AND LATER HE LEARNED THAT TED HAD FILED A CLAIM WITH HIS INSURANCE FOR LOSS OF A AUTO STERO SYSTEM INCLUDING SPEAKERS. (E)

HE SAID HE KNEW THAT TED HAD A PISTOL AND THAT HE AND TED HAD WENT OUT INTO THE WOODS AND SHOT GUNS BEFORE. HE HAS NOT HAD ANYTHING MUCH TO DO WITH TED SINCE HE TORE UP HIS CAR AND ADDED THAT THAT TED AND HIS BROTHER BOTH WERE JUST NOT RIGHT AND WERE JUST DIFFERENT THAT OTHER PEOPLE AND LIKED MATERIAL THINGS. (F)

HE ALSO SAID THAT HE WAS IN THE MOTORCYCLE SHOP ON LEE ST. YERDAY THE 18TH AND HIS FRIENDS THERE WERE TALKING ABOUT TED BUYING THE MOTORCYCLE SO SOON AFTER PATRICIAS DEATH AND ALL OF THEM THOUGHT THAT IT WAS A IN HIS WORDS, CRUMMY THING TO DO. (G)

5. Reporting Officer/Assignment: DET. J.D. CHURCH

A- I wouldn't call him friend if he was the last man alive.

B- Coward "Kettle calling it Black!" when I met him I wondered why he didn't have any friends. I found out the hard way. He's always ripping people off.

C- I never agreed to pay for anything. He was having problems with his car a week before I drove it. He claim to have fixed. Let me drive his car then claimed I tore it up. I was 19 or 20 years of age.

D- Bought my first motorcycle from him for \$4500.00 not \$6000.00 I paid him cash because that's what he wanted. I had just gotten my insurance settlement. Scott taught me how to drive a motorcycle.

E- I filed a claim on approx 4-5000.00 claim on stereo equipment stolen out of my car, Patricia and I went out one evening (91 or 92) we left my car in the parking lot at Lyles. When we came back my window had been knocked out and my stereo equipment was gone. I filed the report and claim. The insurance company paid and also investigated I never heard anything. Scott and I went maybe a year without talking over the car but were on speaking terms again. He now owns a house by this time and no longer lives with his mother Linda, while at his house I discover a board in which had been stolen from my car. I confront him about it and he tries to pay me off. Wrote me a check for \$800.00 Five hundred to cover my deductible and Three hundred for my time. On the check he wrote speakers etc... I refused and left. He got all scared and gave me none back. I never said anything.

F- Scott hasn't ever spoken to Ronnie except maybe once or twice in his life. I know he hasn't at all the past 5 or 6 years

G- I was having a few small problems on my new bike. While out riding I ran into Scott. He gives me a business card and says he now works on Bikes on the side. He fixed it alright, cost me \$235.00 and a month later I had the motorcycle shop fix it correctly. Scott did people the same way when he worked on their car.
