YOUR RIGHTS

Before we ask you any questions, you must understand your rights.

- ①. You have the right to remain silent. *yes*
- ②. Anything you say can be used against you in court. *yes*
- ③. You have the right to talk to a lawyer for advice before we ask you any questions and to have a lawyer with you during questioning. *yes*
- ④. If you cannot afford a lawyer, one will be appointed for you before any questioning if you wish. *yes*
- ⑤. If you decide to answer questions now without a lawyer present, you will still have the right to stop answering at any time. You also have the right to stop answering at any time until you talk to a lawyer. *yes*

WAIVER OF RIGHTS

I have read the above statement of my rights and have also had my rights explained to me by a law enforcement officer. I understand these rights. Knowing these rights, I do not want a lawyer at this time. I waive these rights knowingly and willingly agree to answer questions and/or make a statement. *yes, yes, no*
